


9TH ALL INDIA B-SCHOOL SURVEY 2018





The Methodology

Despite of economy slowdown, MBA/PGDM is still one of the most coveted post-graduate programs in the country. Professional management programs are based on the premise that people can learn to manage business situations more effectively and precisely. However, mushrooming of a number of institutions/B-schools providing business management education/courses in the country is diluting the prestigious degree. The gulf between the top business schools and run-of-the-mill institutions is widening. While India's top business schools are increasingly being recognized internationally, the remaining thousands of management institutes in the country are struggling even to fill their empty seats.

Eventually it is needed to separate the wheat from the chaff and bring out the best B-Schools in the country. "Civil Services Chronicle" invites Business institutes/schools to participate and provide their objective data for Best B School Survey 2018. The research team designed a structured Questionnaire based on certain parameters. The study had following major steps.

Step 1: Desk Research & Factual Data Collection

A comprehensive list of MBA institutes was generated with the help of internet, magazines and other publications. The various sources used for generation of MBA institute list included: AICTE/ AIU/ UGC approved list of institutes/ universities, List of institutes/ universities from previous surveys which offers 2 years full time Programme in Management. Initially a list of 600 B-Schools was compiled by the research team. It was pre-decided that only 3 years old schools are included. The questionnaire was sent to all the B-Schools. A web link www. chronicleindia. in, is also provided on the website to download the questionnaire form. Factual info was collected in the month of October 2016 through the questionnaire. 75 colleges responded with information, and out of which 60 colleges are considered for analysis and 15 colleges did not meet the criteria set by the research team (such as institutes which are not working from 3 years and lack of supporting documents). Factual data sheet was focused on the following information areas:

- General information of the institute: Establishment, Institute type, Affiliation etc.
- Selection criteria
- Infrastructure.
- Faculty
- Intellectual capital
- Industry interface
- Placement
- Alumni chapter National & International

Step 2: Validation of data through physical Survey

In this step, the research team of Chronicle physically visited in many participating B-Schools. The team interacted with the directors, faculty members, current students, academicians. The data was validated and different parameters were critically analyzed. A sample survey was conducted in select cities like Delhi-NCR, Ambala, Panipat, Jaipur and so on. Certain respond-

ent categories were interviewed to evaluate a MBA institute viz. those who had the experience of such Institutes. The respondent categories included:

• Experiential

- * Faculties of MBA Institutes
- Alumnus of MBA Institutes
- HR Consultants who hire from MBA Institutes

Perceptual

- Students aspiring to take admission in a MBA Institute
- Parents of students aspiring for admission in a MBA Institute.

Step 3: Analysis: Final Ranking of MBA Institute

A robust approach was followed to arrive at the final rankings. The step by step process is given below:

Perceptual Score

- * Ratings on various parameters for each institute
- Calculating importance of various parameters to arrive at weights for each parameter – we used a regression model to arrive at the importance of various parameters.
- Calculation of raw scores and weighted scores for each parameter.
- Calculation of overall score for each institute using important weightages.

• Factual Score

- The information collected corresponded to similar parameters as in the perceptual survey. A detailed scoring system was developed for each parameter.
- After assigning scores to each parameter, raw scores were calculated.
- The fi nal institute score was calculated as in the perception survey.
- The final score for a MBA institute was an average of Perception Score and Factual Score - equal weightage (50:50) was given to both.
- There were some newly established MBA Institutes that showed very good performance even though they have been established only recently and hence were not eligible for main rankings. However, it would have been an omission if they were not mentioned both from the point of view of readers as well as from other colleges' perspective. To make a mention of such colleges, we created a category of "Emerging MBA Institutes" which fulfilled the following criteria:
- ❖ As per the score alloted to each, the colleges were categorized by giving different ratings-A+++, A++, A+, A. B++ and B+.
- The Rating has been presented statewise, citiwise & alphabetically.
- The Placement data was critically analysed, This year in our survey, we have presented the average package offered by different stream of companies graphically.


